Tuition is due the first lesson of each month.

Make-up Lessons: Students must notify *Teacher* of a lesson cancellation a minimum of 24 hours prior to lesson time. If at least 24 hours notice is given, then a make-up lesson will be scheduled at the earliest possible date. No refunds will be given for lessons missed because of vacations, special school programs, or student illness without 24 hours notice Exceptions are *serious* illness or a death in the family.

If it is necessary to cancel a lesson without making it up (per the guidelines above) please call no later than noon of the lesson day. There will be no refund for missed or forgotten lessons. There are no exceptions to this policy.

Music Books and Supplies: New students will be furnished with lesson and assignments books at the first lesson, payable on receipt. During the semester, additional music for recitals, competitions, and materials such as metronomes and flashcards will be supplied, payable on receipt.

Recitals/Competitions: Numerous opportunities are available for students to share their music with friends and family and to develop performance skills. A schedule will be provided in the fall to allow time to arrange your plans accordingly.

Students may be selected to participate in judged competitions, if interested. These experiences give students an incentive for hard work, provide an objective evaluation of their performance, and result in a feeling of accomplishment. Entry fees for recitals and competitions are payable on receipt.

Practice Time: Work with your child to set up a daily, uninterrupted practice time to establish a routine. Students are encouraged to keep a practice record, and to work toward musical goals rather than simply counting minutes. The study of music is rewarding and enjoyable, but it is also work! As you know, your child will only be as committed as you are. To insure that you get your money's worth out of piano lessons, I need parents' help to motivate and support students, and to make music study a productive experience.
