## Regarding Practicing

Every student must practice at least 100 minutes per week (20 minutes per day - five times per week). Please read the "Practice Agreement" for more information concerning practicing. Needs of Beginning students will be accessed when practice assignments are given.

An assignment sheet is provided which includes a form for recording daily practice times, to be checked by the student. Parents of Elementary and Middle School students are asked to sign the assignment sheet. High School students should be capable of recording practice time and signing their own assignment sheets.
